Developing Teachers for better care and Education:

Morgan Gerst has been awarded a T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® OHIO CDA Assessment Scholarship. This program was created to provide educational opportunities for childcare providers. The scholarship pays for the CDA assessment fee and a 1% raise or \$100 bonus.



Seedlings with FFA

National Trail Local School District FFA continued the Seedling Project by creating outdoor raised beds in the playground. National Trail students visited classrooms 3 times during the school year to start the seeds, explain growing and the types of soil. The NT students taught and worked with Mini Mind children to start the beds, add soil and plants. Children are now growing tomatoes, watermelon and other produce.
